June 3, 2014 at 12:30 PM

This is to notify you of a public hearing scheduled for June 3, 2014 beginning at 12:30PM at the San Pedro Public Library (931 S. Gaffey Street San Pedro, CA 90731).

Project Title: Coastal Development Permit (CDP) Application No. 14-05 for the Hamilton Avenue Widening – Patton Avenue to Barbara Street (W.O. E1907726).

Project Background: Because of the unpaved condition of Hamilton Avenue, vehicles travelling on the road causes air quality impacts by kicking up dust. Erosion and mudflows during rain events impact the water quality of storm water runoff and catch basins downstream.

Project Description: The proposed project will improve the northerly side of Hamilton Avenue with a half-width road (18-foot roadway and 17-foot sidewalk/parkway combination). Hamilton Avenue will be developed to City Local Street design standards. This will provide paved access to residences taking access off of the north half of Hamilton Avenue and vehicles traveling west on Hamilton Avenue, and reduce air quality and water quality impacts by removing a dirt/gravel road and replacing it with a paved road. The project will be constructed by the City of Los Angeles, Department of Public Works (DPW), Bureau of Engineering (BOE). Operation and maintenance of the project will be carried out by the City of Los Angeles, Department of Public Works, Bureau of Street Services (BSS).

You and other interested persons, as well as the applicant may speak at the hearing or submit written information. All written comments received on or before 4:00PM on June 4, 2014 will be considered prior to a decision on the case.
